



# 2009-10 One Voice for Volusia Member Survey Results

Every year, One Voice for Volusia conducts its annual membership survey, typically during the summer months. The 2009-10 Coalition Membership Survey was conducted via the use of a hand-held polling system during the June coalition meeting as well as through the provision of Survey Monkey, an online survey program. Approximately 33% of the total membership completed the survey, resulting in 97 individual responses.
