WELCOME AND ROUNDTABLE INTRODUCTIONS

COMMUNITY EFFORTS TO CONNECT TO THE FAITH COMMUNITY; ONE VOICE ROLE

Ms. Schlageter briefly reviewed the history and efforts of this committee. She opened the floor for discussion regarding the marketing of the 2010 Health and Human Services Summit (handout), requesting additional suggestions of faith-based organizations to invite to be a vendor. - Staff will market the Health & Human Services Summit to the faith community (expand marketing outreach efforts).
- Efforts will continue to be made to ask coalition members what their needs/wants are in regards to connecting to the faith community.
